The trips include a skills review covering relevant subjects such as avalanche awareness, use of avalanche transceivers, route finding, crampon and ice axe use, rope team management and more. Backcountry Skiing Trip Information

Haines: Haines Alaska is the starting/finishing place for this trip. Haines is a small community located along the fjords at the top of the Inside Passage. The natural beauty and wilderness access found here are responsible for Haines' reputation as a center for wilderness adventure in Alaska.

Getting to the Mountains: Depending on weather/route conditions, we may utilize a variety of modes for transportation into the mountains. Primarily, we will ski in and ski out of our locations to ensure that travel into the mountains is safe and efficient. We have potential to also utilize ski planes for an additional cost (weather dependent).

The Mountains: Haines borders Glacier Bay National Park. The Park and the adjacent 27 million acres, including Wrangell-St Elias National Park, comprise the largest protected wilderness area on the planet. It is an extremely jagged, glaciated, mountain landscape. This terrain is amongst the best in North America for skiing.
